

## CARD/ENVELOPE HOLDER

1. 7 x 13 cut one outside cover  
7 x 11 cut two pockets  
7 x 12 cut one lining  
6 ½ x 12 Quilt Magic fusible fleece  
21" Ribbon

Cut above measurements of fabric, fleece and ribbon.

2. Fold 7x11 pockets wrong side together matching short ends, press.
3. Lay 7x13 cover right side up and arrange folded pockets matching raw edges with cover. Cut 21" ribbon in ½ and insert between 2 layers on each side to be sewn into ½" seam. Sew seam.



4. Lay fabric out and use placement stickers to center embroidery on each pocket and front cover.



Embroider the words "Cards" and "Envelopes" on pockets. If you would like, embroider the initial on the front cover at this time also. I chose to use the Jenny Haskins Decoupage Method for my cover initial giving it more dimension.

5. Center and fuse fleece to the wrong side of 7x12 lining.

6. Lay cover & pockets right side up & center lining wrong side down on top.



7. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam along both long sides creating a tube.

8. Turn tube right side out and press.



9. Trim corners and turn the pockets to hide the end seams.



10. If you would like you can close the holder and sew about  $\frac{3}{4}$ " in to create a space to hold the pen.



**11.** If you have not embroidered your initial you can use the Decoupage method mentioned earlier and use fabric glue to apply the initial to the front cover.



You can use this same pattern to make business card holders, checkbook covers, etc... when you cut your pieces down in size to fit your project.
