Jenny Haskins Stabilizer Quick Reference Guide



Fabric Type	Design Type	Jenny Haskins Stabilizer Recommended
Woven Cotton (Quilting, Muslin), Batiste, Denim (shirt weight) Linen, Broadcloth, etc.	Solid and Dense	<p>Tearaway Magic Heavy Fusible[®], Tearaway Magic Heavy[®], Sheer Magic Plus[®], Water Soluble Magic[®] as the topping</p> <p>If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, prepare the fabric first with Sheer Magic Plus[®]. Float one layer of Tearaway Magic Heavy[®] under the hoop to support the excess stitches in addition to the Tearaway Magic Heavy Fusible[®].</p>
Woven Cotton (Quilting, Muslin), Batiste, Denim Linen, Broadcloth, etc.	Open, Airy, No Outline, Satin Stitch Monogram, Satin Stitch Applique	<p>Tearaway Magic Fusible[®], Water Soluble Magic[®] as the topping</p> <p>If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, float one layer of Tearaway Magic[®] under the hoop to support the excess stitches in addition to the Tearaway Magic Fusible[®].</p>
Silk, Silk Dupioni, Satin, Taffeta	Solid and Dense	<p>Tearaway Magic Fusible[®], Sheer Magic[®]</p> <p>Fuse Sheer Magic[®] to prepare the fabric, stabilize with Tearaway Magic Fusible[®]. If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, float one or two layers of Tearaway Magic[®] under the hoop to support the excess stitches.</p>
Silk, Silk Dupioni, Satin, Taffeta, Lamè	Open, Airy, No Outline, Satin Stitch Monogram, Satin Stitch Appliqué	<p>Tearaway Magic Fusible[®], Sheer Magic[®]</p> <p>Fuse Sheer Magic[®] to prepare the fabric, stabilize with Tearaway Magic Fusible[®]. If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, float one or two layers of Tearaway Magic[®] under the hoop to support the excess stitches.</p>
Towel, Terry Cloth	All Designs	<p>Hoop Magic[®], Heat Magic[®] as the topping</p> <p>If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, float one or two layers of Tearaway Magic[®] under the hoop to support the excess stitches.</p>
Velvet, Velour, Sport Suede	All Designs	<p>Hoop Magic[®], Heat Magic[®] as the topping</p> <p>If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, fuse one layer of Sheer Magic Plus[®] to the back of the fabric to prepare it for the embroidery.</p>
Polar Fleece, Meinke	All Designs	<p>Any "Pressure Sensitive" Stabilizer:</p> <p>Hoop Magic[®] or Dissolve Magic Sticky[®] *Use this product when no stabilizer needs to be left behind.</p> <p>Use Water Soluble Magic[®] or Dissolve Magic[®] as the topping.</p>

Fabric Type	Design Type	Jenny Haskins Stabilizer Recommended
Knit – T-shirt, Pique, Sweatshirt, etc	Light *8,000 stitches or less	<p>Cutaway Magic Fusible® Water Soluble Magic® or Heat Magic® as the topping</p> <p>If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, float one or two layers of Tearaway Magic® under the hoop to support the excess stitches.</p>
Knit – T-shirt, Pique, Sweatshirt, etc	Medium to Heavy	<p>Cutaway Magic Fusible® Water Soluble Magic® or Heat Magic® as the topping</p> <p>If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, float one or two layers of Tearaway Magic® under the hoop to support the excess stitches.</p>
Sweater Knit	All Designs	<p>Hoop Magic®, Cutaway Magic Fusible® Water Soluble Magic® or Heat Magic® as the topping</p> <p>First fuse Cutaway Magic Fusible® to the back of the sweater to create a non-stretch fabric. Finger press the sweater to the Hoop Magic®.</p>
Cotton Organdy, English Netting, Nylon Organdy/ Organza, Tulle or Netting, Sheer/See through fabric	Light	<p>Dissolve Magic Sticky®</p>
Free Standing Lace	Open Lace Designs	<p>Dissolve Magic®</p> <p>Use two layers for dense free standing lace designs.</p>
Wool, Wool Blend, Flannel	All Designs	<p>Tearaway Magic Fusible® Heat Magic® as the topping</p> <p>If the design is large, overly dense or poorly digitized, float one or two layers of Tearaway Magic® under the hoop to support the excess stitches.</p>
Hard to Hoop Fabrics and Items – Napkin Corner, Handkerchief, Collar, Socks, Ties, Backpack, Handbags, Pocket Top, Cuffs, Blanket corner, Shirt Placket, Fabrics that are prone to Hoop Burn	All Designs	<p>Choice of “Pressure Sensitive” Products: Hoop Magic® or Dissolve Magic Sticky® Use this product when no stabilizer needs to be left behind.</p>
Hard to Hoop Fabrics that can be perforated by needle: Leather, Pleather, Ultra-Suede, Oil Cloth	All Designs	<p>Hoop Magic®</p>
